AWARENESS TIPS: Scholastic Development Ideas

Activities

▲ Presentations/Workshops

- Host a speaker on "Effective Study Habits"
- o Conduct a workshop where seniors assist others with class selections
- Host a speaker on the educational and academic support areas available on campus and online
- Host a presentation that provides tips for applying to scholarships
- Invite your Chapter Advisor or other faculty initiate to share tips on succeeding in college

▲ Encourage Studying

- o Set individuals and chapter goals for term GPAs
- Schedule a weekly study/ library hour for chapter members and pledges
- Host study rooms before midterms and finals
- Keep attendance at study hours and put perfect attendance names into a drawing for a \$50 or \$100 textbook scholarship
- Avoid chapter meetings/events during exam weeks
- Create and distribute a finals/midterms care package for brothers to study (study snacks, Emergen-C, pens, pencils, flashcards, etc.)

▲ Provide Resources

- Promote available scholarships, identify academic eligibility for scholarships and encourage members to apply
- Establish study pals among members with same majors
- Maintain a class resource list each term for members to know which other members have the same class/professor at different times
- Have members share a class report, paper, project, or presentation with the chapter
- Have content specific experts within the chapter offer assistance to other members
- Have third and fourth year students advise first and second year students about the different majors and assist in major/career exploration
- o Use faculty initiates as subject-matter experts to assist members

Recognition

- ▲ "A" and other good grades on a paper, test, or project
 - o Announce "A" grades during chapter meetings
 - Have brothers sign their name to a poster/chalk/whiteboard at the front of the room to be recognized
 - o Give small awards/candy to each brother
 - Have each brother write their name on a slip of paper and draw a winner for a larger prize
 - Pass out Smarties Candies to those that have done well in class

▲ Dean's List

- Publish a list of members on the Dean's List on the chapter bulletin board or in the chapter newsletter
- Put all Dean's List names into a drawing for a gift certificate to bookstore, restaurant, etc.

▲ GPA

- Ask your Chapter Advisor to check member grades and give a "Most Improved GPA" Award
- Host a chapter celebration if the chapter-wide GPA increases from one term to the next
- Pi Award- Present each brother who has achieved a 3.14 GPA or better during the term with a slice of pie or other small gift
- ▲ Have brothers who have not skipped class since the last meeting or for the week put their name in a Skippy jar. Draw a name and give a small goody bag at the end of each meeting.
- ▲ Celebrate major milestones in a member's academic journey (such as professional admissions for those schools that have prerequisites)
- ▲ Publish and celebrate Foundation scholarship winners during a chapter meeting
